

- National AAPG award nominations due on January 31st, no extensions, online process
- Advisory Council currently focused on push for more diversity, focused effort on distinguished service award for this year.
- A lot of the awards are for lifetime service to AAPG. Distinguished service can have multiple awardees and can be award for a single event.

4. Committee Reports:

SWS-2019 Convention:

- Convention update, only a few talk spots left to fill. Pioneer sponsoring an afternoon of talks on Monday. Keynote and DPA Ethics talks have been arranged. Diverse other talk topics.
- Still lots of room for posters, bring as many as possible. Discuss funding for student poster presenters, revisit next meeting. Need to advertise at meetings, check interest vs cost to attend.
- Space for 40+ exhibitors, currently 11 have paid spots.
- Student Expo on Monday afternoon chaired by Joe Davis; will have an Industry in 2025 discussion panel, requesting Denise to be present for this event. Joe needs her contact info.
- Jeff Aldrich: AAPG cutting costs; going forward we need to request certain leadership to be present for sectional meetings rather than sending several people. Targeting 1-4 members of the Executive Committee, + Mike Party. We need to send an EC request to AAPG by mid-February.
- More Rocks in Your Head: SWS and WTGS both donate \$3k each
- Utilize ¼ page advertisement in AAPG Explorer allowed for each society to publish larger advertisement for the SWS Convention. Use SWS, AGS, RGS, DGS, FWGS, NTGS ¼ credits.

Awards Committee:

- Have a nominations for every award, one teacher applied at national level.
- Teacher of the Year deadline is February 1st, other award deadlines are February 15th.
- We need to make sure to invite recipients to the SWS Dallas convention to accept their awards!

Continuing Education Committee: Short Course

Fort Worth has 190 attendees at the course on 01/24; estimated 123 attendees at the Abilene course on 01/25. Will provide a more robust summary at the next BOD meeting.


Scholarships & Grants:

- Invite Operations, Landmen, & Engineers to increase participation

Dallas Geological Society

- Report overview, 271 active members. Please read through report.
- Looking for 4 new DGS AAPG delegates

El Paso Geological Society

- Currently have 70 members, merged meetings with UTEP AAPG Student Chapter
- Fall field trip in November was at the City of Rocks, NM; possibly plan a spring trip

Fort Worth Geological Society

- FWGS provides 3x scholarships per year to local universities, sending out info soon
